



Title II Report Summary 2008-2009

As reported to the NJ Department of Education under Title II of the Higher Education Act as the “summary pass rate”, 100% of students who completed Montclair State University’s programs for initial teacher certification in AY 2008-2009 passed the PRAXIS test required for licensure by the state of New Jersey. As required under Title II, pass rates were reported only for assessments with 10 or more test-takers. An aggregate pass rate of 100% was calculated for the academic content areas (math, English, biology, etc.).

The percentages of students who passed the individual (“single”) PRAXIS assessments are as follows:

Art: Content Knowledge	100
Elementary Education: Content Knowledge	100
English Language, Literature & Composition	100
Health & Physical education: Content Knowledge	100
Mathematics: Content Knowledge	100
Music: Content Knowledge	100
Physical Education: Content Knowledge	100
