Admission Standards applicable to internal Families, Children & School Setting transfer students:

Undeclared to FCSS

Other Major to FCSS

Other FCST Concentration to FCSS

The department will accept up to 30 total internal transfer students per academic year. Priority will be given based on class standing and credit completion.

Students with 60 or more credits will not be considered

Application Process and Due Dates:

1. Acceptance Deadline for Fall semester: October 15th
Acceptance Deadline for Spring semester: February 15th
2. Students must have a *minimum* of 3.0 GPA overall and in FCST major.*
3. Students must have completed FCST 200 with a grade of B or higher.
4. Students must complete the “Change of Major Form.”
5. Students must attach a copy of their Analysis of Academic Progress from WESS.

Please note that this is a competitive process—completion of a change of major form and meeting the minimum criteria listed above is not a guarantee that a student applying for internal transfer will be accepted into the concentration. Decisions will be made once each semester following the deadline, and there will be No Waiting List. A student not admitted in a given semester may apply in a subsequent semester. Students will be notified via email, there is no need to call the department.
